TAG Directed Study

- Available at all grade levels
- A self-directed course with guidance from a teacher
- Meets daily
- Elective credit received
- Number grade earned

TAG Career Internship

- Available to TAG juniors and seniors in good standing
- A student may take up to four internships (each is one semester long).
- Prerequisite – *Hire Me!* seminar

AP Capstone Diploma

- Available to rising 10th and 11th graders
- Requires a 2 year commitment: one year taking AP Seminar and one year taking AP Research
- The College Board requires that a student make a 3 or higher on 4 additional AP exams to earn the Capstone Diploma
